



## **LAIS Special Educational Needs Policy (June 2019)**

As the Lower Austrian International School is a selective high school for semi-professional athletes we generally do not have students with special educational or physical needs. Nevertheless, as a public building, the school follows Austrian law and is therefore accessible for people (e.g. injured students, visitors ...) with impairments as it is equipped with the following features:

- An orientation system for blind people including an information board and signs in Braille writing
- Two disabled parking spaces
- Two elevators
- One toilet for the disabled on every floor (equipped with emergency buttons)

The school had one integrated class from 2014 until 2019 including one student with permanent physical impairments, who graduated in June 2019. This was an exception and the student brought his own carer to school.
